The exchange programme Memory Work sponsored by the Federal Foundation for the Study of Communist Dictatorship in East Germany provides you with the opportunity to conduct international research on your specific topic, establish new contacts and gain experience at foreign institutions.



In the context of this programme all employees and staff members of NGOs, memorial sites, archives, museums and similar establishments dealing with reappraisal and remembrance may complete a stay at a corresponding institution in a foreign country for up to three months.



The aim of the exchange programme Memory Work is to support transnational collaborations in the reappraisal of dictatorships and experiences of state violence, to help stimulate the exchange of experience and to promote the interaction between individual researchers and institutions.
