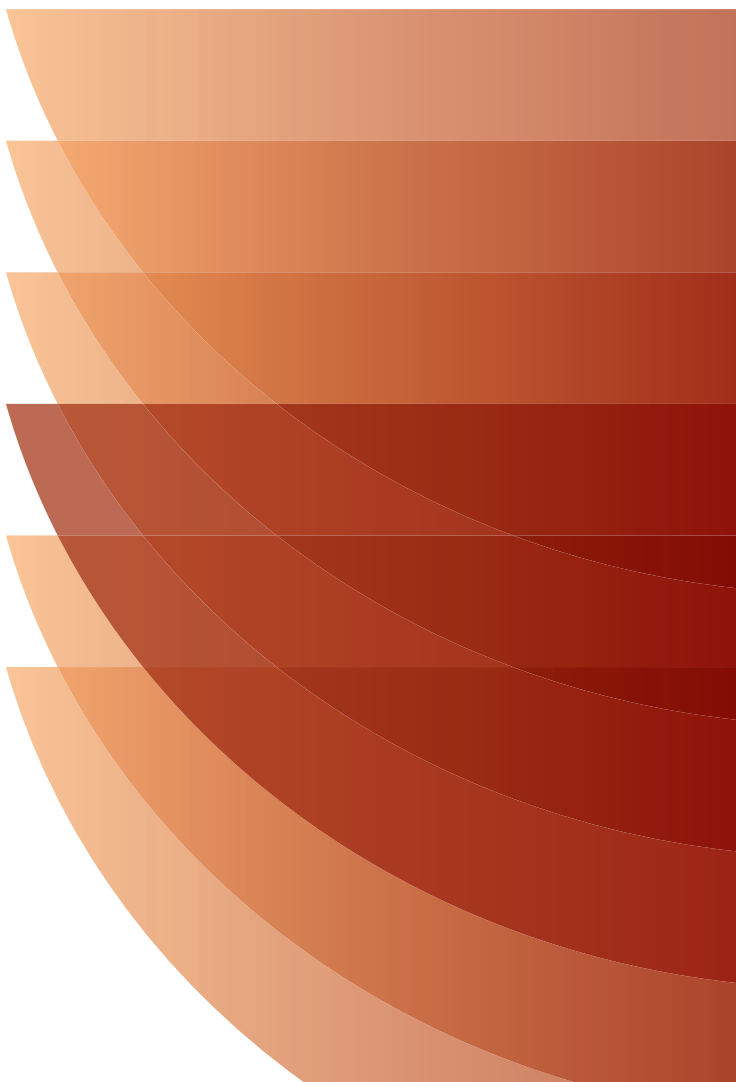

A series of events organized by the Federal Government Commissioner for the New Federal States and the Federal Foundation for the Study of the Communist Dictatorship in Eastern Germany

Different forms and aspects of the social and legal processes of coming to terms with the past after war, tyranny and dictatorship(s) are examined through various country examples. Representatives of organisations and institutions will provide insights into the development of the culture and politics of remembrance and how they deal with the past in their respective national contexts.
